Dear Artists and Friends:

As another year comes to a close, and we look forward to a new one, I invite you to view the <u>recording of our Annual Meeting</u> on the CMPS YouTube channel for a review of 2023; a summary of our member survey results; and a peek at our plans for 2024 that are in large part based on these survey results. It's important for everyone to stay abreast of both the successes and challenges facing our society, so please take some time to view this video.

It's hard to believe that since our last newsletter we've had another terrific national show (including a public gallery tour with Board members) which you can view here; a great portrait workshop from Jeanne Tangney; an exciting demo on painting birds with Mike Beeman; an artist talk with Pastels Plus juror Pirkko Makela Haapalinna; and going on now—our biannual Signature Members Show and Sale, with representation from nine of our Signature Artists. The public reception for this show is Sunday, **December 3, 1-3 pm.** I'll be there and am looking forward to seeing many of you at this show that will offer, in addition to larger work, smaller pieces priced for holiday giving. The show is open through December 17 at Groton Public Library, 99 Main St., Groton, MA. And see the next section for an announcement of our new Signature Members!

On December 10 we have our final event of the year, an Artist's Talk with Loriann Signori, one of our Marks of Distinction Selection Jurors. After that we will all take an established broak for the holidays, but in the pastel society.

that never sleeps, we are working away toward 2024.

First up: our **Second Annual Pastels Plus International Online Show**. We had a great response to our call for artists to mix pastel with a required 30-50% other medium(s) in 2023, so we are doing it again next year. The prospectus should be available in a few weeks (we'll let you know when), and **submissions will open on January 5 on Show Submit**. So perhaps you will use some of your holiday downtime to experiment with your mixed-media ideas.

On January 13, we will have our first free demo with Javad Soleimanpour, our other 2023 Marks of Distinction juror, who will do a portrait demo for us. Note that you must have renewed your membership for 2024 in order to see this demo for free. You should have received your first renewal reminder by now, and we appreciate your timely renewal as it greatly helps us in our ability to meet our obligations, which includes serving you in the way you have come to expect. Many have already renewed, and we thank you. A reminder out there to all of you who are friends of CMPS, if you are not an artist you can still join as a Supporting Member and enjoy our free demos and artist talks.

You should also have received our **invitation to support our show awards**, in *any* amount or, for \$100 or more, a named award. In particular, we are looking to increase awards for Pastels Plus and our Members Show as well as for our national show. Our shows are growing in popularity with both artists and the public, and we know that cash awards are an important part of shows as well as one of the biggest demands on CMPS finances. When you donate, you can specify if you want the donation to go toward a particular show; if you want to do a named award, contact president@cmpastels.org. Thank you so much for your support! We have already received \$295 in donations toward our \$500 goal, including from nonmembers! We're so grateful.

It's been a satisfying year and we look forward to serving and seeing you, either in person or virtually, in 2024. We wish all our members and friends a holiday season of well-earned relaxation and enjoyment, and renewed inspiration for all your winter-time painting for next year's shows.










Upcoming Events From Our Members
